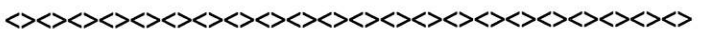

LEAVES

Curbside collection will begin **October 8, 2018**.

FINAL COLLECTION: Leaves must be curbside at 7AM on **Monday, December 3rd**.



... Piles with sticks or other debris will not be collected.
... Avoid placing piles in drainage areas, on road or sidewalks.

... Avoid placing piles close to stationary objects (e.g., mailboxes, fences, hydrants, utility poles, parked cars, trees).

... Maintain safe distances from vacuum truck.

Curbside collection services are not provided on private streets.

BRUSH & YARD WASTE

BRUSH: Sticks & branches up to 6" diameter.

YARD WASTE: Garden wastes, leaves, landscaping and shrubbery pruning.

COLLECTION CYCLE

Begins at 7AM on:
September 10, 2018
October 8, 2018
April 8, 2019
May 13, 2019

DO NOT...

- Tie brush in bundles.
- Bag brush or yard waste.
- Mix brush with yard waste.
- Place debris in drainage areas, on road or sidewalks.
- Place debris near stationary objects (e.g., mailboxes, fences, hydrants, utility poles, parked cars, trees).
- The collection date for any residence is dependent upon weather conditions and volume of collection.
- The Township collects on each street one time during each collection cycle.
- Materials generated by commercial tree & landscaping services must be disposed by the company.



CHRISTMAS TREES

Place trees curbside by 7AM, **Monday, January 8, 2018**.



Remove garland, tinsel, ornaments and lights.
No artificial trees collected.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION

Collection cycle begins at 7AM on the 1st Tuesday of each month.

Glass Bottles & Jars
(Clear, Green & Brown)

East Buffalo Township is required under Act 101 of 1988 to implement recycling programs.

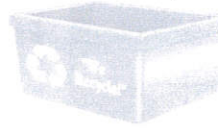
Commercial and Institutional establishments are required to recycle glass, corrugated cardboard and high-grade office paper.

Residents are required, by Township ordinance, to recycle, at a minimum, glass, aluminum, newspaper, plastics, leaves, and tree and shrub waste.
