CURBSIDE COLLECTION

BRUSH & YARD WASTE

SCHEDULE

Materials must be curbside by **7:00AM** on:

September 9, 2019 April 13, 2020
October 14, 2019 May 11, 2020

MATERIALS COLLECTED

BRUSH

Sticks & branches up to
6" in diameter.

YARD WASTE

Garden wastes, leaves,
landscaping prunings.

MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED

Mixed brush & yard
waste
Collected grass clippings
Dirt, sod, rocks
Logs/Firewood

Lumber
Root balls
Stumps
Wood chips

LEAVES

FIRST COLLECTION CYCLE: Begins October 14, 2019.

CONTINUOUS COLLECTION: The Crew will rotate throughout the Township on a continual basis.*

FINAL COLLECTION CYCLE: Leaves must be curbside at 7AM on Monday, December 3, 2019. The Public Works Crew will conduct the final collection rotation.

CHRISTMAS TREES

Collection will begin at **7:00 AM on Monday, January 6, 2020**. There will be one rotation through the Township.

- Be sure to remove garland, tinsel, ornaments, and lights. No artificial trees will be collected.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Be sure that sticks and branches are not mixed in the same pile with yard waste or leaves.
- Place the cut ends of branches facing the street.
- Do not tie brush in bundles.
- Bags of brush or yard waste will not be collected.
- Keep drainage areas, roadways and sidewalks clear.
- Avoid placing materials near stationary objects (e.g., mailboxes, fences, hydrants, utility poles, parked cars, trees) that may prevent collection.
- The collection date for any residence is dependent upon weather conditions and volume of collection.
- With the exception of collection of leaves (*) the Township collects on every public street **ONE** time during each collection cycle.
- Materials generated by commercial tree & landscaping services must be disposed by the company.
- Failure to follow collection guidelines will result in materials not being collected.

Have aluminum cans and glass bottles and jars (clear, green & brown) curbside by **7 AM** on:

SINGLE-STREAM

Plastics #1 through #7 are acceptable for private hauler single-stream recycling containers.

DROP-OFF CENTER

Restaurant take-out containers, regardless of the type of plastic, are **NOT** permitted at the Drop-Off Center.

Bath, kitchen and laundry containers that are #1 and #2 plastic bottles and jars are accepted.

East Buffalo Township is required under Act 101 of 1988 to implement recycling programs.

Commercial and Institutional establishments are required to recycle glass, corrugated cardboard and high-grade office paper.

Residents are required, by Township ordinance, to recycle, at a minimum, glass, aluminum, newspaper, plastics, leaves, and tree and shrub waste.
